### Whetley Academy's Pupil Premium Allocation for 2016 - 2017

### How will the grant be spent in 2016-2017?

The grant will be spent to close the academic gap between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged pupils by:-

- Providing additional Maths and English support/ interventions
- Providing effective Inclusion support to ensure smooth transition into school and ongoing pastoral support for children and their families.

<p><b>Inclusion Provision</b> PP Pupils assessed as vulnerable using the Boxhall Profile to be prioritised for Nurture intervention. Early intervention for KS1. Also KS2 interventions. Additional Attendance Officer support to ensure at least national expectation of 95% for all PP pupils. Additional support from Pastoral Leader and Inclusion leader for pupils and their families, including faster track access to external services and support. E.g. School Nursing Team, CSC, Families First etc. (Staffing, equipment and teaching materials)</p>	<b>£140,000</b>
<p><b>English and Maths Interventions</b> PP pupils targeted for interventions in addition to Quality First Teaching including Reading Comprehension, Booster Maths, Phonics and tailored interventions. (Staffing, training and teaching materials)</p>	<b>£80,000</b>
<p><b>Additional KS2 classes in Y3/4/5/6 and Additional .6 teacher in Y6 Dec – July.</b> Provides additional smaller class intervention and booster support. (Staffing and teaching materials)</p>	<b>50,000</b>
<p><b>Accelerated Reader Programme</b> I pads, Accelerated Reader books, additional staffing for management of AR programme and Boosters. (Staffing, equipment and teaching materials)</p>	<b>£60,000</b>
<p><b>Additional Reading Books</b> Provide high quality 'real' classroom books that support the development of reading comprehension.</p>	<b>£30,000</b>
