STRATEGY STATEMENT
<p>Our catch up priorities ensure all pupils make accelerated progress across the curriculum as well as supporting children's mental health and well being. Approaches include Reading Plus, Nuffield Early Language Intervention (NELI), Literacy Launchpad, Voice 21 and Thrive. We have spent some of our CCPG on additional IT devices and home learning resources such as CGP guides so that children can continue with their learning either after school or during any isolation with the appropriate resources.</p> <p>These approaches will reduce the attainment gap between our disadvantaged pupils and their peers and raise the attainment of all pupils to close the gap created by COVID-19 school closures</p>
