

Behaviour Chart - Whetley Academy



Consequence:	Action:	Student name:
C1	Remind the pupil of expectations at Whetley Academy.	
C2	Remind the pupil again and reinforce why they have progressed to C2.	
C3	Take pupil out of class for a 1:1 conversation. Remind them and discuss how they can alter their behaviour	
C4	Will lead to break time or lunchtime detentions. A C4 must be logged on CPOMS and parents should be informed at the end of the day or by phone call.	

C5	Given for unacceptable behaviours such as; walking out of class, repeatedly refusing to follow a reasonable instruction , swearing, hurting another child, threatening behaviour , destructive and/or unsafe behaviour. A member of the Leadership Team will be called for at this stage. Pupil will work for a half day on their own in an area appropriate to the age of the child and the design of the academy. The pupil will be issued with a breaktime/ lunchtime detention. Unable to attend after school club
C6	Progression to a C6 may result in exclusion; this will be issued for extreme behaviours such as: Physical violence against another pupil or adult with intent to harm, or health and safety issues such as frequent non-compliance, refusal to follow behaviour policy putting themselves or others at risk of harm.

C5 and C6 are for staff to be aware of, but not to have on display.
