

## Whetley Academy Pupil Premium Review:

### Aims and Outcomes 2020-21

Covid 19 had a significant impact on outcomes in 2020-21. Our strategy document for 2021-2022 reflects this and aims to address gaps and issues which have arisen as a result of the pandemic.

<b>Aims</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Accelerate progress in Reading, Writing and Maths and Phonics in all year groups through targeted intervention and support.</li> <li>Persistent absence to be targeted by the Attendance Officers to increase attendance.</li> <li>Provide support for children to enable them to manage their feelings and behaviour in line with the behaviour policy.</li> <li>To strengthen parent partnerships so that parents are able to support their children effectively.</li> <li>To enable pupils to access activities within and beyond the curriculum.</li> </ul>	
<b>Objective 1 and 2</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide staff with appropriate CPD to implement catch up plans and close gaps in reading, writing, maths and phonics for pupils.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All staff have received CPD for Reading, writing, maths, phonics, wider curriculum and Thrive from either academy, Delta or external providers. This, in turn has led to the results below.</li> </ul>
<b>Objective 3 and 4</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Accelerate progress in reading, writing, maths and phonics using targeted support and intervention.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(9/11) 82% PP passed PSC in June 2021.</li> <li>Y2 – Reading All PP pupils have increased their score.</li> <li>Y6 – Reading = 64% at 100 or above.</li> <li>Y6 - Writing = 68% ARE</li> <li>Y6 – Maths = 71% ARE</li> <li>All pupils have increased their scores.</li> </ul>
<b>Objective 5 and 6</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Improve attendance by targeting PA pupils and increasing rewards to close the gap between pupil premium and non pupil premium pupils.</li> <li>To ensure pupils are ready to learn by providing essentials such as breakfast, uniform and support for families.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attendance improved for most PP children. PP 20-21 – 90.5% Non PP 20-21 - 91.3%</li> <li>Free breakfast club attendance increased.</li> <li>Uniform supplied for identified pupils.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To ensure pupils have access to activities within and beyond the curriculum.</li> </ul>	<p>Subsidised visits for PP children. Links made with local football club. Summer school available for identified pupils.</p>
<b>Objective 8 and 9</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To support pupils to have positive mental health and the ability to manage their own emotions and behaviour in line with the behaviour policy.</li> </ul>	<p>Thrive training and resources. Action plans for identified pupils in place.</p>
<b>Objective 10</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To improve pupils' confidence in speaking clearly and coherently.</li> </ul>	<p>Debates with Green Lane Academy. Assemblies over zoom. Discussions with other classes over zoom.</p>
<b>Objective 11</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Strengthen partnerships with parents/ carers so that they, in turn, can support and encourage their child(ren) as well as developing their own knowledge and skills.</li> </ul>	<p>Contact increased with parents to support through lockdown. Identified parents to start parent group in Sept 2021.</p>
